

Attachment 1 – Equipment and Gear

Training Clothing:

BDUs/ ABUs, and PT Gear to include...

Running Shoes

Complete, inspection-ready battle dress uniform (insignia, patches, boots, etc)

3 pairs of boot socks

4 Black T-shirts (for BDUs/PT Gear)

2 pairs of Black Running Shorts

3 pairs of white (athletic) socks

3 sets of undergarments

Dark Blue/Black Jacket (optional, but recommended during periods of inclement weather).

Uniform Checklist:

CAPID

Cadet grade insignia (can be from BDUs/epaulets if officer)

Dress blues nameplate

Ribbons w/rack (no double-spaced racks)

Garrison cap w/emblem (or insignia if officer)

Black dress socks

Shoes, black military issue, low-quarter (Females, no heels)

1-2 pair of garters/shirt stays

Short-sleeve dress blue shirt (tuck-in style for females)

Dress blues pants (properly hemmed)

White V-neck T-shirts

Dark blue belt w/silver tip and buckle

Medals of any sort are not authorized for wear on the short-sleeve dress blue uniform when part of a Color Guard Team.

Dress Blue Skirts are not authorized for reasons of uniformity as part of a Color Guard Team.

Other Required Items:

Iron and spray starch

8+ medium/large safety pins (bring 4+ of each is possible)

Writing materials (pocket-sized notebook and 2 pens)

Sleeping bag (and pillow)

Toilettes (soap, deodorant, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)

Razor w/shaving cream/electric razor – male

Comb/brush (if needed). ***Males, be sure to get a regulation haircut before the event.***

Shower shoes

Bath towel (white)

Wash cloth (white)

Laundry bag

Wrist watch

Hairpins/rubber bands (required for long hair) – female

Makeup (minimal) – female

Hair dryer/hair spray/hair gel – female

*****Important: Color Guard Gear*****

2 flagpoles w/flags (American and State **or** American and Unit flags authorized)

2 harnesses for flagstuffs
2 Parade Rifles
2 parade belts
4 sets of white gloves (gripper gloves are preferred)

Squadrons sending less than 4 cadets are still requested to bring enough gear for a full team.

Squadron Commanders: Submit an e-mail with your name, squadron charter, and cadets attending, verifying what all gear you will be sending with your cadets. We do this to ensure that all squadrons get their own gear returned at the end of the training, and also to be able to know ahead of time that all cadets will have the required gear for training. It is up to the squadrons and individual applicants to ensure that they will have the required gear to train.

Under certain circumstances, squadrons desiring to send 5+ cadets can be paired off with squadrons sending 3 cadets or under. Don't wait to the last minute to ensure you have the required gear for the amount of cadets you are sending.
